Through Neurodiverse Pathfinders, this grant seeks to encourage more growth from Neurodiversity and mental health related groups and communities within the UBC Vancouver campus. This will hopefully allow these communities to continue to make UBC an even more inclusive university. A total of \$1000 will be allocated to this fund over the entirety of each AMS fiscal year. The fund will be divided into 2 terms, with each term promising to provide \$500 out of the total \$1000.
